Main Floor Overview

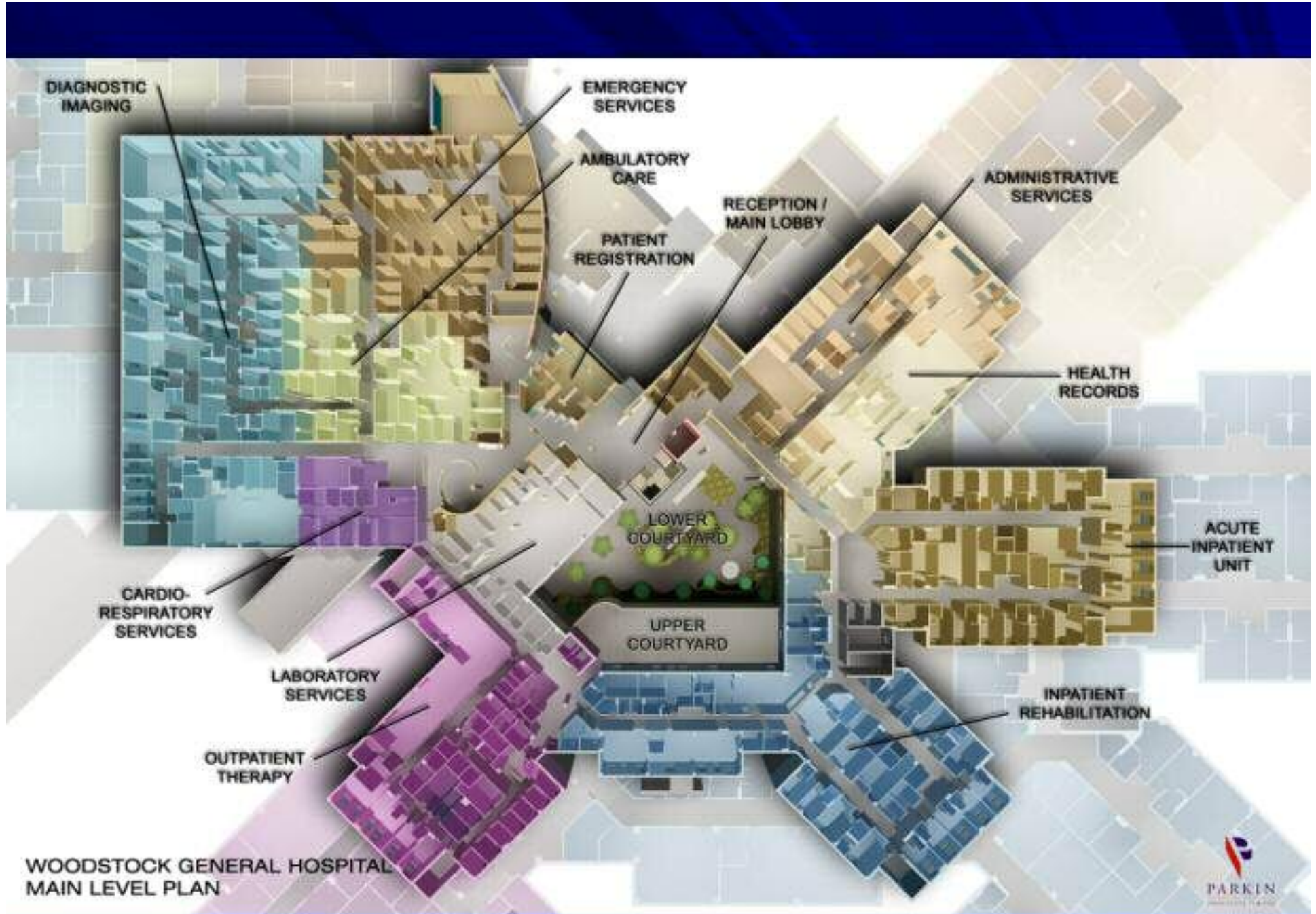
- 18 single rooms for Med/Surg or Rehab flexibility
- 2 Bariatric rooms with oversized furniture and ceiling lifts to accommodate large patients
- Enlarged Emergency, Laboratory Services and Ambulatory Care departments
- Increased space for outpatient and inpatient therapy
- Easy access to Health Records, Administration, Foundation, Lifeline and Volunteer Services



Main Floor Overview

- Large open lobby with glass featured staircase
- Separate entrance for Emergency
- Private ambulance garage
- Patient Registration, reception, gift shop easily accessed from lobby





Upper Level



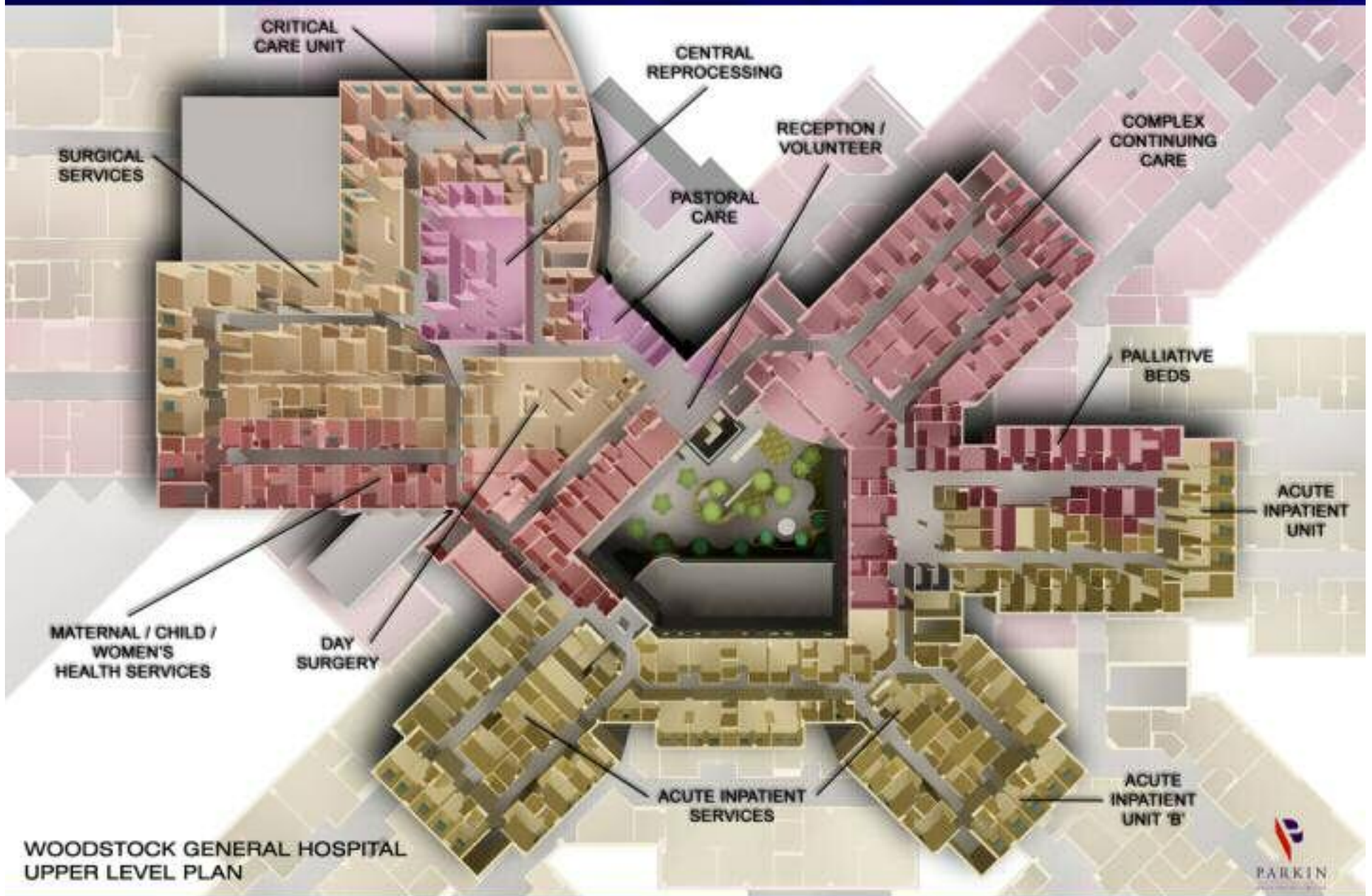
- Palliative and Critical Care units have waiting rooms



- Non-denominational Chapel featuring stained glass windows from current chapel

Upper Level

- Maternal/Child/Women's Health Unit with 5 labour/birthing rooms, 7 private rooms and 1 semi-private room
- Expanded Endoscopy Suite
- Surgical Day Care Unit
- Complex Continuing Care Unit, complete with dining area and outdoor balcony overlooking courtyard
- 4 wings containing patient beds



Lower Floor

- Cafeteria with large windows leading to upper floor and walk out accessibility to main courtyard
- Three large education rooms that easily convert to an auditorium
- Material management and receiving
- Environmental Services



Lower Floor

- Automated Pharmacy featuring unit dose dispensing; reducing waste and human error
- Chemotherapy suite
- Back entrance on the level leading to
 - Diabetic Education
 - Dialysis Unit with 12 stations
- Education Services, Human Resources and Information Management
- Inpatient and outpatient Mental Health Units including a private courtyard
