Accreditation decisions are based on compliance with standards, **Woodstock Hospital was evaluated on 2,359 standards**, of those standards WH was in compliance with 99.5%. In addition, WH met every test for compliance for ALL **31** Required Organizational Practices. By achieving Accreditation with Exemplary Standing, Woodstock Hospital will not undergo another accreditation survey for four years!
