Construction broke ground at the new hospital site in November 2008, to be completed on time and under budget in June 2011. On November 20, 2011, hospital staff and patients were moved, unit by unit, into the new hospital.

Over the last decade, the new hospital has been awarded high honours such as Accreditation with Exemplary Standing by Accreditation Canada, silver level certification in Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design; has been recognized for its Emergency Department wait times and efforts in energy conservation; and has welcomed the addition of many talented staff members, services, and cutting-edge technology.

Each of these special guests played a key role in the planning and execution of the new hospital build, ten plus years ago.
