Inaugural Radiothon supports Woodstock Hospital's Maternal Child Unit

The *Heart FM Give Thanks to Your Hospital Radiothon* is an exciting new event in Oxford County taking place on Thursday, October 12, 2017 that will bring together the community to support the Woodstock Hospital Foundation.

The Radiothon will be in support of the hospital's Maternal Child Unit. For twelve hours, stories about the hospital's Maternal Child Unit will take over the airwaves. Interviews with hospital staff will highlight the importance of what we are raising money for, while patients and families will share their personal stories of the Maternal Child Unit. The community will be encouraged to phone in or stop by the hospital to support the needs of the Maternal Child Unit.

The technology required to deliver, monitor and care for newborn babies is continuously evolving and improving, which makes the need to update the hospital's existing equipment and purchase new technology ever present. Woodstock Hospital is the designated birthing centre for Oxford County; with the number of deliveries growing each year, we need to invest in the tools required to meet the needs of the community. In 2016, WH had 900 births, an increase from 874 births in 2015. With the addition of a fifth obstetrician this year, the Maternal Child Department expects to deliver over 1,000 babies annually.
