Accreditation Canada has adjusted assessments to be suited to the COVID-19 reality, with assessments involving remote teams of experts combined with on-site surveyors.

Accreditation decisions are based on compliance with standards. **Woodstock Hospital was evaluated on 1828 standards**, and of those standards WH was in compliance with 97.3%. In addition, WH was in compliance with **ALL** Required Organizational Practices. By achieving Accreditation with Exemplary Standing, Woodstock Hospital will not undergo another accreditation survey for four years.

"Achieving this level of accreditation assures our patients, families and caregivers that the care and services they receive at Woodstock Hospital, meet nationally recognized standards for best practices and patient safety," said Jayne Menard, VP of Patient Care and Chief Nursing Officer.

Some of the highlights and strengths acknowledged by the accreditors included:
